- 1) Household income limit (includes the applicant and other adult occupants contributing to living expenses) will be based on established indexes and will be adjusted annually at the first ACOVA meeting of the calendar year.
 - a. Income must be at or below 60 percent of North Dakota's median income and within these limits (based on annual LIHEAP limits).

- 2) Eligibility will be determined based on net income of the most recent three (3) month period.
- 3) Public Assistance (i.e., Food Stamps, TNAF, Fuel Assistance) will not be counted as income.
- 4) Allowable expenses under Policy 615 will be deducted from Net Income
- 5) Dependent children's income will not be counted.
- 6) Documentation will be required.
